CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS - MEN

1. The Club Championship for the men will be played over 72 holes.

2. The Club Championship and other associated events is a members only event and is open to all male members with the exception of Juniors and Veterans.

The Junior and Veterans events is open to all male and female members who's membership categories allows 7 day/Saturday play. Specifically these are Full Golf, Long Standing Senior, Golf Life, Senior and Junior.

3. The Championship for other scratch events including A Reserve, B, C Grades, Junior, and Senior as well as all nett events including the Veterans Championships will be played over 54 holes.

4. The timesheet for the championships will be under the normal Friday night arrangements.

5. Dates for each round:-

Round 1 – Saturday 12th October 2024

Round 2 - Saturday 19th October 2024

Round 3 - Saturday 26th October 2024

Round 4 – Sunday 27th October 2024 for Club Championship only - Top 16 seeded draw only.

6. Normal handicap limits apply to each grade. Juniors must be under 18 years of age at the start of the Championship (12 October 24). Senior Championship open to members 50 years and over at the start of the Championship (12 October 24). Veterans Championship open to members 65 years and over at the start of the Championship (12 October 24)

7. An increased competition fee applies and is to be paid on the day of each and every round. To be advised closer to event.

8. Each round has a separate day event - except final round of Club Championship.

9. A compulsory seeded draw will be made of the leading 8 players (scratch) for the 3rd round of the Club Championship on Saturday 26 October 24 - tee off from 11.30 am. There will be a cut made after round 3 of the leading 16 players (scratch) plus ties for the 4th round for the Club Championship which will be played on Sunday 27 October 24 - tee off from 11.00 am. Players who do not play their allocated time will not be eligible to win the Championship.

Qualifying begins Saturday 9th November 2024

1. Prizes will be based upon the amount of funds collected over the qualifying period. There is a one off entry fee of \$10 plus \$2 for each attempt at qualifying for the final. All monies collected will be applied to the total prize pool.

2. The Penrith Top Gun is a members only event and is open to all male members.

HOW TO QUALIFY

1. A once only \$10 entry fee payable to the Pro Shop prior to your first attempt to qualify.

A payment of \$2 to the Pro Shop at each attempt to qualify.

3. The Pro Shop will imprint your scorecard with a "TOP GUN" stamp on payment of a \$2 qualifying fee (YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAKING SURE YOUR CARD IS STAMPED).

4. All score cards must be submitted because this is the only way to determine the fee's collected.

5. Qualifying or attempting to progress up the leader board can be on the following designated competitions day when a singles event is run: Saturday, Sunday, Wednesday, and Open Event on Public Holidays. No qualifying allowed Fridays nor Monday Senior Competition days.

6. Qualifying is the aggregate score of the best two (2) Nett scores received per player. A minimum of 10 rounds must be played to qualify.

7. The Top Gun Champion from the previous years event will be an automatic qualifier for this years event and will be qualifier number 19.

8. Your aggregate qualifying score needs to better any player already on the leader board. The purpose of this is to encourage players to continue to attempt to qualify.

9. In the event a tied aggregate Nett score comes in on the same day, the qualifier with the earliest lowest single Nett score takes precedence (e.g. player 1 has Nett 66 & 69, player 2 has Nett 68 & 67. Player 1 is the higher qualifier and player 2 is positioned next on the leader board).

10. The distribution of prizes will be announced once the total value of the prize pool is known.

11. This event is under direct control of the Golf Committee and all protests and disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final.

12. A leader board notice will be displayed in the club and at the Pro Shop.

13. The last day for qualifying will be Saturday 22 March 2025.

THE PENRITH TOP GUN FINAL RULES

1. The final will be played as a stroke event according to the R&A and USGA Rules of Golf excepting that the committee may direct that certain player(s) may not need to hole out if it is obvious that the player(s) will not have the highest net score on that hole. The committee will be judicious in the use of this decision.

2. 19 players will tee up together on the 1st tee at 10:30 am on Sunday 30 March 2025

3. All players to play off the Blue markers. All Balls in use must be marked by an official – labelled 1 to 19, any replacement balls must be also be marked before playing your next shot.

4. The player is responsible for marking his ball on the putting green.

5. The player with the worst net score on the 1st hole is eliminated; the same applies on the 2nd through to the 17th, If there is a tie for the worst net score on holes 1 through 17 a "CHIP OFF" will determine which player drops out, the spot to be determined by the Golf committee and the ball that is furthest from the hole will be eliminated even if the ball is on or off the putting green.

6. The player who is the lowest qualifier will CHIP OFF first etc.

7. The remaining 2 players left on the 18th will fight it out to find the "TOP GUN", in the event of a Tie the players shall replay the 18th until a winner is declared.

8. All competitors will play off their current handicap, except that the current handicap shall not be greater than the handicap used by the competitor to qualify for top gun, or in the case of last years Top Gun Champion the handicap on the day of the previous years Final.

9. Motorised transport is not permitted on the final day of play (carts can only be used where a written medical exemption is produced), the exception is if a play-off is required on the 18th motorised transport may be used, any disputes must be lodged to the committee during the play of the hole and the committee's decision is final.

10. All qualifiers plus reserves (if notified) must attend a pre-match briefing.

11. All protests and disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee within 5 minutes of completion of the each hole. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final.

TOP GUN - WOMEN

NOTE: A MINIMUM OF 5 ROUNDS MUST BE PLAYED TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE FINAL.

1. Open to all Lady Members, scores may be taken from singles competitions played on a Thursday throughout the specified time frame.

2. Cost is \$25.00 for registration to be paid to the Nominated Committee Member before the commencement of their first round of Top Gun and this will will include all Thursday cards between March and October.

3. This is not a compulsory event. It is the players own decision if they wish to participate in Top Gun.

4. Players can register and compete from Thursday 7th March 2024 and any other Singles competition conducted through to Thursday 24th October 2024. Upon payment of the \$25.00 fee all Thursday cards submitted during this period will count towards the competition.

5. The Match committee will collate scores and adjust against DCR of the day if necessary – updated results will be emailed out to all spasmodically throughout the year. Scores will be recorded in Nett Order with daily ties being decided by normal count back rules.

6. The aggregate of the best 2 adjusted scores (based on CCR of the day) will be your qualifying score.

The qualifying date will be the later of:

-the date of the last of your two low scores or

-the date you submit your 5th card.

7. Ranking will be determined based on the lowest qualifying score. (Aggregate of best 2)

Where the scores are the same the first to qualify, based on the earliest qualifying date, will take precedent.

8. A players score will need to better the scores already on the leader board, to progress up further.

TOP GUN FINAL RULES

FINAL - 15 Holes to be played on Thursday 21st November 2024 and will be conducted as follows:

a. Players with the best 16 Nett Scores will hit off the 4th hole in reverse order position 16 through to 1 (using their current handicap on the day.) If any player is not available then the player/s with the next best score will be included

b. Play will be STROKE play and the player with highest Nett Score for each hole will be excluded from the next hole/s of play.

c. In the event of a tie for the highest Nett score a chip off will be conducted (place to be decided by Committee on the day) with the player furthest from

d. A player may exclude themselves from a hole at any time thus finalizing that hole and play proceeding to the next hole.

e. At the conclusion of the 18th hole, if the last 2 players have the same nett score, players are to replay the 18th hole until a result is achieved, in this case a toss will be conducted to determine who tees off first, this order will be kept for all subsequent playoff Holes.

f. All monies received will be tallied and distributed back to the top 16 players in Club Vouchers on a sliding scale from 1st to 16th position and will be presented at the Xmas Cheer presentation.



AUSTRALIA DAY CUP

1. The Australia Day Cup will be conducted on Saturday 27th January 2024. This is a closed event and is strictly for members only.

2. Ties shall be decided on count back.

3. 18 holes individual stableford.

4. This event is under direct control of the Golf Committee and all protests and disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee within 30 minutes of completion of the event. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final.

5. No player may win more than one trophy.

Trophy allocation

1. Australian Day Cup – best 18 hole nett score.

Best scratch score - and runner up if > 100 players.

3. 18 holes nett winners and runners up in each grade.

PENRITH EASTER CUP

1. The Penrith Easter Cup will be conducted over 18 holes on Saturday 23rd March 2024. This is a closed event and is strictly for members only.

2. The event is an 18 hole Individual Stableford event for members only in A, B & C Grades.

3. Ties in all events shall be decided on count back.

4. This event is under direct control of the Golf Committee and all protests and disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee within 30 minutes of completion of the event. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final.

5. No player may win more than one trophy.

Trophy allocation

18 holes Nett winner (Cup) and runner up

18 holes Nett winner and runner up – A, B & C Grades

18 holes Scratch winner and runner up if sufficient players

ANZAC DAY CUP

1. The ANZAC Day Cup will be conducted on Saturday 20th April 2024. This is a closed event and is strictly for members only.

Ties shall be decided on count back.

3. 18 holes individual stableford.

4. This event is under direct control of the Golf Committee and all protests and disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee within 30 minutes of completion of the event. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final.

5. No player may win more than one trophy.

Trophy allocation

1. Anzac Day Cup – best 18 hole nett score.

Best scratch score - and runner up if > 100 players.

18 holes nett winners and runners up in each grade.



AUTUMN & MASTERS CUP

1. The Penrith Autumn and Masters Cup will be conducted on Saturday 27th April 2024. This is a closed event and is strictly for members only.

2. Ties shall be decided on count back.

3. This event is under direct control of the Golf Committee and all protests and disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee within 30 minutes of completion of the event. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final.

4. No player may win more than one trophy.

Trophy allocation

1. Penrith Autumn Cup – 18 holes team aggregate Nett stroke score. Team to comprise of 4 members. The three (3) best Nett scores to determine team score.

2. Penrith Masters Cup – 18 holes team aggregate scratch score. Team to comprise of 4 members. The three (3) best scratch scores to determine team score.

3. 18 holes individual stroke Nett score – winner and runner up.

4. 18 holes individual stroke scratch score – winner and runner up.

5. This event is a stroke event.

Any player not completing the round will not be eligible to win a prize or trophy.

CAPTAIN'S KNOCKOUT

1. The Captain's Knockout is a members only individual handicap Matchplay event using the Match Index on the scorecard.

No nomination fee is applicable to this event.

3. The nomination sheet will be on available in the Pro Shop leading up to the event (if not enough members qualify on the qualifying day, those who have listed will be balloted into the draw. Qualifiers receive priority and will be seeded.). Nominations open Friday 15 March 24 and close Friday 19 April 24.

4. The qualifying round is on Saturday 20 April 24.

Rounds are played 11 May 24, 18 May 24, with the Semi Finals 25 May 24, and the final 15 June 24. Tee times for all rounds other than qualifying will be from 11.12 am.

5. The normal member competition fee is payable on the day and you <u>will not</u> be included in the event of the day except NTP's.

6. The Top 16 members from the qualifying round will be seeded and block times assigned on the timesheet.

7. All matches will be played from the competition of the day tee markers.

8. All matches must be played on the scheduled date and time.

9. Lowest handicap golfer in the group goes to scratch and the difference of the remaining handicap (to a maximum of 18) will determine the match index for each hole. All players are to use their current handicap per round to calculate the match index.

10. Matches that finish all square after 18 holes will continue on a sudden death basis until a winner is obtained.

11. The winners of each round are responsible for recording the result on the draw sheet located on the notice board.

12. This event is under direct control of the Golf Committee and all protests and disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee within 30 minutes of completion of any round. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final.



FAMILY CUP

1. This event will be held on Sunday 16th June 2024 in conjunction with the event of the day.

2. Entry is open to all members of the Club who are family members who are both members of Penrith Golf Club.

Family members are defined as immediate family or household, and includes spouse, de facto partner, child, parent, grandparent, grandchild or sibling; or a child, parent, grandchild or sibling of the members spouse or de facto partner.

3. The event will be a 2BBB Stableford with a trophy being awarded to the winners.

All ties in will be decided by count back.

5. This event is under direct control of the Golf Committee and all protests and disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee within 30 minutes of completion of the event. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final.

SPENCE WOOD KNOCKOUT

1. The Spence Wood Knockout is a member only 2 person team Matchplay event.

2. The nomination sheet will be on display on the Club Notice Board leading up to the event. (if not enough members qualify on the qualifying day, those who have listed will be balloted into the draw. Qualifiers receive priority and will be seeded.) Nominations open Friday 7 June 24 and close 28 June 24.

3. No nomination fee is applicable to this event.

4. The normal member competition fee is payable on the day and you will not be included in the event of the day except NTP's.

5. The qualifying round is on Saturday 29 June 24.

Rounds are played 13 July 24, 20 July 24, with the Semi Finals 27 July 24 and the final 10 August 24.

6. You must play with your partner in the Qualifying Round.

7. The Top 16 teams from the qualifying round will be seeded and block times assigned on the timesheet.

8. All matches will be played from the competition of the day tee markers.

9. All matches must be played on the scheduled date and time. Players can participate without their partner being present.

10. Lowest handicap golfer in the group goes to scratch and the difference of the remaining handicaps (to a maximum of 18) will determine the match index for each hole. All players are to use their current handicap per round to calculate the match index.

11. Matches that finish all square after 18 holes will continue on a sudden death basis until a winner is obtained.

12. The winners of each round are responsible for recording the result on the draw sheet located inside the pro shop.

13. This event is under direct control of the Golf Committee and all protests and disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee within 30 minutes of completion of any round. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final.

FOURBALL KNOCKOUT - WOMEN

1. Played off the FULL difference between the stroke play handicaps on the day of the match.

The lowest marker concedes strokes to the other three including her partner.

Example: Player A on a handicap of 10 receives nil, her partner

Player B on a handicap of 24 receives 14 strokes (diff of 24 & 10),

Player C on a handicap of 28 receives 18 strokes (diff of 28 & 10), and

Player D on a handicap of 38 receives 28 strokes (diff of 38 & 10).

If this Handicap exceeds 18, players shall receive 2 strokes per hole where applicable.

2. Strokes must be taken as per the Golf NSW International Match Play Index.

3. Matches square at the 18th must play on until a result is achieved. Shots to be given again where necessary, same as for 1st 18 holes originally played.

4. Matches can be played prior to the Thursdays scheduled date for that round if all players agree. Players must report to the starter 15 minutes prior to the

5. A. - Caddies are permitted. Please notify opponents.

B. - Motorised transport is permitted

6. Players are NOT ELIGIBLE for Nearest the pin or Eclectic on the day match is played.

7. Players can not play knock-out in conjunction with another event.

8.Knock Out Rounds to be played ahead of the field

9. Final may have an appointed referee by the Match Committee.

Note:- The Match Committee reserve the right to amend the above if it is deemed necessary

3. Open to members and visitors.

4. This event is under direct control of the Golf Committee and all protests and disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee within 30 minutes of completion of each event. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final.

Monday Veterans Challenge

1. The Challenge will be played over 72 holes with the best 3 of the 4 scores counting.

2. The Challenge is a nett stableford event for players over 50 years of age as at 1 January of the year of competition.

3. The timesheet for the Challenge will be under normal arrangements.

4. Dates for each round:-

Round 1 – Monday 6th May 2024

Round 2 – Monday 13th May 2024

Round 3 – Monday 20th May 2024

Round 4 – Monday 27th May 2024.

5. An additional competition fee is payable which will be advised closer to the date of competition. Normal competition fee is payable in each round.

6. Each round has a separate day event and normal fees and prizes apply.

Trophies and prize money determined from the aggregate of the best 3 stableford scores over the 4 rounds, (the worst score is not counted).
 All ties will be decided by count back.

7. This event is under direct control of the Golf Committee and all protests and disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee within 30 minutes of completion of the event. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final.

XMAS CHEER

1. Conducted on Sunday 8 December 24.

2. Played as a 4 Person Ambrose event with a shotgun start.

3. Event open to members only.

4. Visitors can play on invitation from a member subject to available tee times and with the approval of the Golf Committee.

5. This event is under direct control of the Golf Committee and all protests and disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee within 30 minutes of completion of the event. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final.
