

2024 Matchplay Championships Playing Conditions and Dates

Please insert your name on the nomination sheet if you are interested in playing and available for the 2024 Matchplay Championship.

Nominations open: Friday 12 January 2024

Nominations close: Your Tee Time Saturday 20 January 2024

Qualifying rounds (Top 8 qualify each grade): Saturday 20 January 2024 and Saturday 3 February 2024

Round 1: Saturday 10 February 2024 - (tee times from 11:12am)

Semi Finals: Saturday 17 February 2024 - (tee time at 11:12am)

Final: Saturday 24 February 2024 - (tee time 7.30 am for Matchplay Championship and 11:12am for other grades)

Please note – all matches must be played on the specific dates and at the specified times.

Only exception will be if course is unplayable in which case the Golf Committee will re-schedule matches.

Playing Conditions

- 1. The championship will be contested in Club Matchplay Champion, A Reserve, B Grade and C Grade.
- 2. There is no nomination fee payable for this event, but the normal competition fee is payable in each round to increased cover cost of prize money
- **3.** Qualifying will be over two rounds of medal play, conducted in conjunction with the January Monthly Medal on Saturday, January 20, and February Monthly Medal on Saturday, February 3.
- 4. The top eight players based on 36-hole aggregate scratch scores in each grade qualify for the match play rounds. Grading will be based on your daily handicap on the first qualifying round. In the event of ties, a countback will be conducted based on Round 2 scores.
- 5. Nominations please enter your name, handicap, member number and phone number on the nomination form attached. Nominations will close at your tee time on Saturday 28 January 23.
- 6. Knockout Rounds Round 1 will be conducted on Saturday, February 10, the semi-finals on Saturday, February 17, and the finals on Saturday, February 24. You must play at your allocated tee time.
- 7. All matches will be played over 18 holes except for the Club Matchplay final, which will be played over 36 holes. All rounds are off the blue plates.
- 8. The Field
 - Players will be seeded one to eight in each grade based on aggregate score over the 2 qualifying rounds with 1 versus 8; 2 versus 7; 3 versus 6; and 4 versus 5,
 - A reserves list will be created in the event players in the match play field are forced to withdraw prior to the first round. If this occurs, the draw will not be remade. If a player withdraws, the first reserve will assume his seeding in the draw.
- 9. All disputes must be referred to the Golf Committee in writing within 30 minutes of each match. Decisions made by the Golf Committee will be final
